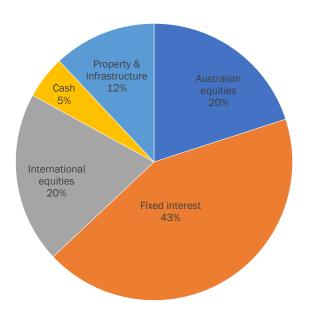


What is the risk/return profile of a balanced portfolio?

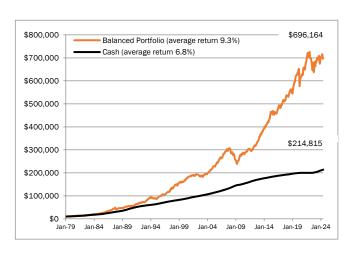
Asset allocation of a conservative portfolio

A balanced portfolio targets an asset allocation of 48% in defensive assets and 52% in growth assets:



This portfolio is recommended for investors who understand and are moderately comfortable with investment risk, and/or require modest returns to meet their objectives.

Annual returns on \$10,000 investment on 1 Jan 1979 to 30 Jun 2024 (income re-invested)



Historical range of returns (per annum) Income re-invested



Key questions about risk	
Historically, how often has a portfolio with a	Once in every
balanced asset allocation incurred a loss?	8.5 years
What has been the largest loss incurred over a 12 month period?	16%
How long did it take for the portfolio to recover from this loss?	23 months
Historically, what has been the likelihood	
this portfolio could experience two	1.47%
consecutive 12 month periods of negative	likelihood
returns?	



Pros

- Moderate long term returns
- Provides moderate protection against inflation

Cons:

- Moderate likelihood of a negative return over a 12 month period
- Moderate variance in returns from year to year
