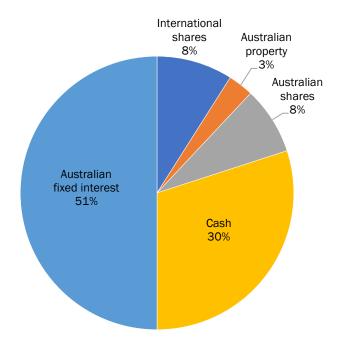


## What is the risk/return profile of a defensive portfolio?

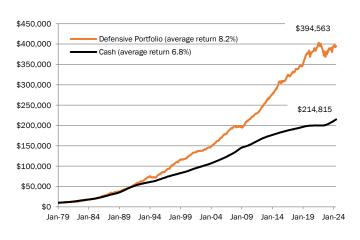
### Asset allocation of a defensive portfolio

A defensive portfolio targets an asset allocation of 80% in defensive assets, and 20% in growth assets:



This portfolio is recommended for investors who are uncomfortable with investment risk, and/or require modest returns to meet their objectives.

Key questions about risk	
Historically, how often has a portfolio with a	Once in every

Historically, what has been the likelihood	
this portfolio could experience two	0 likelihood

returns?	



#### Pros

- Low likelihood of a negative return over 12 month period
- Low variance in returns from year to year

### Cons:

- Low returns over long term
- Provides limited protection against inflation
